

*Transription of Thomas Pell's Treaty*  
*June 27, 1654*

Know all men by this present y<sup>t</sup> we Shawanarockquót: poquorum: Anhōōke: Wawhāmkus: Mehumōw: Beinge ye true owners & y<sup>e</sup> only Lawffull Heyres & proprietors off a piece of land Bounded by ye Sea to y<sup>e</sup> South w<sup>th</sup> y<sup>t</sup> Tract off land Called by ye English Longe Island; to ye west & west & by South w<sup>th</sup> y<sup>e</sup> bay & River & River Diawockinge Acqueonunge (Chemaqūanaock to ye East) w<sup>th</sup> all ye Islands y<sup>t</sup> are in ye salt water to ye South South East & South West Against y<sup>t</sup> Tract off Land w<sup>ch</sup> is Beffore expres<sup>d</sup>; w<sup>h</sup> all trees medowes & all Land w<sup>h</sup> in y<sup>e</sup> tract off Land w<sup>ch</sup> is Beffore Expressed: doo sell & deliver to Tho<sup>s</sup> Pell now inhabitinge in Fayrffield his heyres & assignse to hould injoy improove plant as hee shall see cause to his Best to be improved ffor & to him & his heyres fforever w<sup>h</sup> out any molestation on our p<sup>t</sup> And doo herby ingage our Selves to make good our selves against all Claymes intayled either by Dutch or Indiyans w<sup>t</sup> ever & doo deliver it into ye posession off ye sayd Tho<sup>s</sup> Pell & his Assignes: markinge ye bounds to ye mayne Land w<sup>ch</sup> is & shalbe y<sup>e</sup> present bounds to ye mayne Land: only Liberty is ffreely graunt ffor ffeedinge offe cattle & Cuttinge off timber beyound those Bounds; & wee doo Acknowledge to have Reseved in full for it ye trou valew & just Satisfaction Accordinge to our Estimate to w<sup>ch</sup> we sett our hands beffore these wittnesses off English & Indiyans this twenty seaventh off June 1654.
